

LESSON 13: The C position – Left hand – Bass Clef

Fingering: 5 4 3 2 1



- These five notes are part of the “C position” on each hand
- We begin with our finger 1 on the Middle C up to the G note with our finger 5. Notice that below each note we have the correspondent finger with which we play the notes.
- On the left hand will be the opposite: The C is played by the 1st finger and the G by the 5th finger.
